Development through the Life Cycle

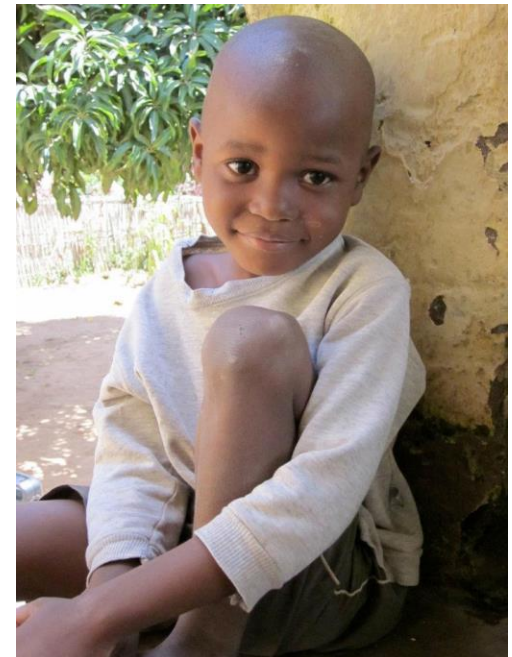


- What are the trade-offs in intervening throughout childhood and adolescence?
