Condition	Intervention	Avoidable burden in low and middle income countries	Cost-effectiveness	Implementation cost (US\$ per head of population)	Feasibility of scale-up
Chronic pain	Oral morphine	Incremental number of pain-days per year avoid- ed (millions): Chile:0.9 Romania:1.9 Uganda:3.6	Incremental cost per year of pain-free life added ranges from \$216-420 in these three LMICs	Chile: \$0.06, Uganda: \$0.18, Romania: \$0.10	Can be delivered in a community setting
